A Brief Profile

Sarojini Naidu Vanita Maha Vidyalaya established in the year 1962 by the Osmania Graduates' Association and the Exhibition Society is one of the largest Women's College in the country. The college is re-accredited by NAAC with 'A' grade. It is a moment of pride and privilege as the institution has celebrated the 50 years of its glorious and golden existence in the year 2012. Spread over 3.8 acres in the sprawling Exhibition Grounds, the college is affiliated to Osmania University and offers Intermediate, Undergraduate and Postgraduate courses, including Masters in Business Management.

The college with good infrastructure, spacious classrooms with glass boards, adequate rest rooms and mineral water plant caters to the needs of around 3300 students. The spacious laboratories with modern apparatus and equipment, books in three separate libraries for U.G., P.G., and M.B.A. provide an advanced learning experience for students. The college has an auditorium of 572 seating capacity named after the founder member of OGA, **Sri Shankerji**, for seminars, conferences, orientation programmes, various competitions and cultural programmes of the college and also OGA.

The college Hostel accommodates 450 inmates from neighbouring districts.

The college has over 360 systems. There are separate Computer Labs for Commerce, Science, English and M.B.A. Departments. All the Departments are provided with computers, for research and advancement of the faculty.

1. Rules of Admission

- a. Admission to all classes will be strictly on the basis of merit and reservation.
- b. No Donation for admission is accepted.
- Candidates are expected to preserve the counterfoil of the fee challan and produce it at the time of admission.
- d. The list of candidates selected for admission to various courses will be displayed on the notice board of the college. No intimation will be sent individually. Candidates should periodically check with the college office about the likely dates of the display of lists.
- e. If a candidate fails to pay the fees within the stipulated time, she will not be considered for the subsequent lists.

2. Reservation of seats:

- a) 15%, 6% and 25% of seats will be reserved for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes respectively, subject to the production of Caste Certificate duly signed by competent authorities, at the time of registration.
- b) Seats are reserved for physically handicapped candidates and the children of Exservicemen and Defence Personnel residing in the State. Seats are also reserved for the candidates with merit in Sports, NCC and Extra Curricular Activities, subject to the production of relevant certificates.

Copies of Certificates to be enclosed with the application for admission to UG and PG Courses.

- a) A certified copy of Memorandum of Marks of the qualifying examination.
- b) A certified copy of Transfer Certificate (T.C.) from the School or College where the candidate has studied previously.

- c) Migration Certificate in case of students coming from Boards other than the Board of Intermediate Education, Telangana State.
- d) Candidates coming from other States should give a declaration, prior to their admission to the course, to the effect that no disciplinary action was taken against them by the concerned University or Board.

- f) At the time of admission, the candidate has to submit the following original certificates

4. Rules of Attendance

- a. Students are required to attend at least 75% of the lectures in each subject.

Eligibility Criteria For Intermediate Admissions

- Candidates must have passed the 10th class examination of Telangana State (SSC) or any other examination recognised as equivalent, by the Board of Intermediate Education of Telangana State.
- 2. The Candidates who have passed 10th class examination in other than English Medium are eligible for English Medium if they have secured more than 40% marks in General English in 10th class examination.
- 3. Candidates who have passed 10th class examination with Domestic Science are not eligible for Science group.
- Candidates who have passed 10th class exam from (ICSE or CBSE etc.) other than Telangana State SSC Board must submit eligibility certificate issued by Board of Intermediate Education, Telangana at the time of admission.
- 5. Candidates who have passed SSC with Telugu Medium are exempted from 40% marks criteria in General English for vocational courses.

ATTENDANCE

- 1. STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE 75% ATTENDANCE IN EVERY SUBJECT.
- 2. The examination forms of only such candidates will be forwarded to the BIE who have put in atleast 75% of the attendance before the date of sending the examination forms.
- 3. If a candidate fails to secure 75% attendance, the college has the authority to withhold the examination form and prevent the student from appearing for the Intermediate Examination.
- 4. For the purpose of counting the percentage of attendance the date of commencement of the classes shall be taken into account and not the date of admission of the candidate.
- 10% Medical Leave will be calculated only for those students who produce appropriate Medical Certificate on the day they resume classes.
- 6. NSS, NCC Camps and Sports events will qualify for full attendance during the period of the camps and events only when supporting and relevant certificate are submitted.

LIBRARY

Our students are encouraged to participate in Intervarsity, State, National and International championships and they have brought many laurels and awards to the college.



NCC

NCC with its Motto 'Unity and Discipline' has a great role in the Personality Development of the students and we, at Vanita lay a great emphasis on student participation in NCC. The NCC



unit attached to 1 (A) Girls battalion, has a student in take of 200 cadets and many of our cadets pass the 'B' and 'C' certificate exam conducted by the Ministry of Defense. The Government gives numerous incentives to outstanding cadets like reservation of seats in education, employment, army recruitment and financial assistance through scholarships.

NSS

National Service Scheme with its Motto 'NOT ME BUT YOU', provides an opportunity to the

students to participate in community service. There are 3 units of NSS with 300 volunteers. The NSS unit of our college has adopted 4 villages and 2 villages under the National Extension Scheme in the Karimnagar district. NSS volunteers who put in 240 hours of service and attend two special camps are eligible for merit certificate of the Osmania University which enables them to get preference in admission for higher education. - As per the rules of the Central and State governments, Scholarship is available to the SC, ST, BC and Minority students.

TESTS AND EXAMINATIONS

On Campus and Off Campus interviews are organized and many of our students find placements in companies like WIPRO, INFOSYS, GENPACT, TRANSDYNE etc.

NIPUNI: The Skill Development Centre offers Certificate Courses in various skills like Beautician, Tailoring etc., Students apart from academics can equip themselves with an additional skill.

BANKING AND CIVIL SERVICES COACHING: Students aspiring for employment opportunities in Banking sector can avail Banking

Services Coaching. Civil Services Coaching in the college offers excellent opportunities for recruitment to Services like IAS, IPS at the Central level and Group I and Group II Services at the State level.

COMPUTER CENTRE WITH INTERNET FACILITY: Internet Facility is provided to the students through the computer centre where they can access the latest information and use it for preparation of study material.

HOSTEL: Hostel accommodation is available to students from outside the city. Our hostel can accommodate 450 students. The hostel has Mineral Water Plant, Solar Water Heating system, Gym, Recreation facilities, Library and Computer facility with internet.

MENTORING: Mentoring of students by their concerned class teachers helps in interaction at a personal level to understand the needs and talent of every student and guide them in their endeavours.

COUNSELLING: Student Counseling Centre provides career and personal counseling keeping in mind the growing complexities in the society and the problems faced by the Youth. Awareness lectures on various issues are organized. It also conducts short term courses.

EXTRA AND CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES: Students can participate in various literary and cultural activities and showcase their talent. Opportunities are provided to participate in interclass, inter-collegiate competitions at various levels and win prizes.

ALUMNAE ASSOCIATION: Being out of sight is not being out of mind. The alumnae association provides an opportunity of reunion for all its old students. Many of our alumnae have made the institution proud by their positions in the society.

TELANGANA STATE PROHIBITION OF RAGGING ACT, 1997

SALIENT FEATURES

Ragging means doing an act which causes or is likely to cause insult or annoyance or fear or apprehension or threat or intimidation or outrage of modesty or injury to a student.

No.	NATURE OF RAGGING	PUNISHMENT
1.	Teasing, Embarrassing and Humiliating	
2.	Assaulting or Using Criminal Force or Criminal intimidation	
3.	Wrongfully restraining or confining or causing hurt	h.
4.	Causing grievous hurt, kidnapping or rape or committing unnatural offence	
5.	Causing death or abetting suicide	

NOTE:

- 1. A student convicted of any of the above offences will be expelled from the college.
- 2. A student imprisoned for more than 6 month for any of the above offences will note be admitted in any other college.
- 3. A student against whom there is prima facie evidence of ragging in any form will be suspended from the college immediately.
- 4. In case of the students who are involved in ragging, there shall be an embossment on his marks cards and other academic certificates in bold letters which cannot be obliterated that he had indulged in ragging and had conducted himself in a manner unbecoming of student.
